New funding ensures we are operational until end of this year

We are thrilled to announce some exciting news about funding for Dementia Friendly Worthing!

We successfully applied to the National Lottery Community Fund and Sussex Community Foundation Trust with new initiatives to support local people with dementia and their carers.

We were granted £17,586 from the Coronavirus Community Support Fund, distributed by The National Lottery Community Fund and available thanks to the Government. A further £4,987.50 was from the NET CoronaVirus Fund from the Sussex Community Foundation Trust. Many thanks to both for allocating the funding at this most difficult time for people with dementia.

The funding means we can continue to offer a wide range of online sessions for people affected by dementia and their carers.

We know that getting online isn't easy but with we are now able to purchase handheld tablets which we can loan out to help people access support and information, as well as pre-downloaded music and videos.

The tablets will be set up on an individual basis and will be able to run on 4G so home broadband won't be needed.

Lynsey & Lilian will set these up and teach carers how to use them. Social distancing will be observed as well as PPE worn.

We are also offering Activity and Wellbeing packs to give individuals purpose and inspiration, whilst activities outside the house are limited. The packs will include quizzes, crosswords and gentle exercise routines. If people have specific interests, we can personalise these.

In June, we ran our first Dementia Friends webinar which was very successful. It comprised a short virtual information session to give people more insight into dementia and the actions they can take to improve the lives of people living with dementia and their carers.

The great thing about these sessions are you can join from anywhere – we welcomed people from Colchester, Norfolk and even Cornwall! As well as local attendees from Worthing organisations.

The next of these monthly sessions is on July 7 at 11 am. Lynsey will run these each month and also join up with other alliances to ensure there is a programme available throughout the summer.

We can run these for individual organisations and be flexible around dates and times.
